"In garrison we recommend that each soldier be provided with a \underline{box} or \underline{locker} of the following dimensions, to store his fulldress uniform and extra clothing.

Dimensions of box:

length: 24 inches


breadth: 12 inches – in the clear height: 10 inches – in the clear

To be constructed of pine 3/4 of an inch with iron hinges 10 inches in length 1 1/2 inch wide, with lock and key. These boxes to be permanent fixtures of the barricks."

Overall dimensions: ("in the clear" means inside measurements)

length: 24 inches hinge 14 x 1 3/4 width 13.5 inches hasp 10 x 1 3/4

height: 11.5 inches
