

# 1874 Soldier's Clothing Locker

from: Infantry Equipment Ordnance memoranda No. 19 Page 59

“In garrison we recommend that each soldier be provided with a box or locker of the following dimensions, to store his full dress uniform and extra clothing.

Dimensions of box:

length: 24 inches

breadth: 12 inches – in the clear

height: 10 inches – in the clear

To be constructed of pine  $\frac{3}{4}$  of an inch with iron hinges 10 inches in length  $1\frac{1}{2}$  inch wide, with lock and key. These boxes to be permanent fixtures of the barracks.”

Overall dimensions: (“in the clear” means inside measurements)

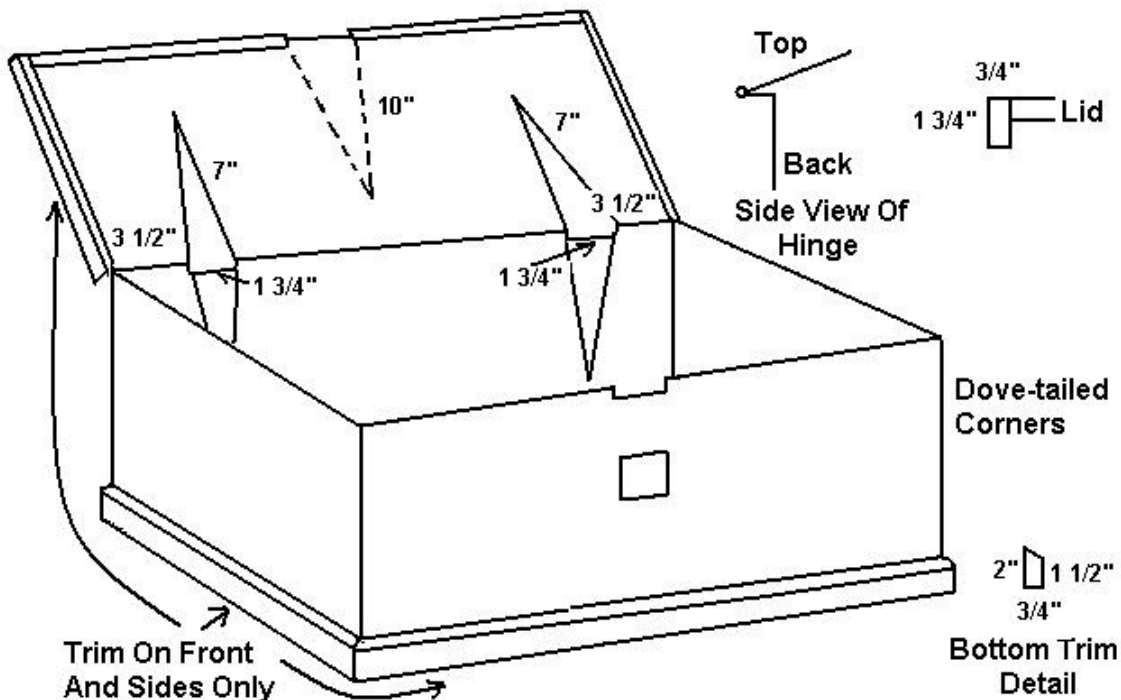
length: 24 inches

width 13.5 inches

height: 11.5 inches

hinge 14 x  $1\frac{3}{4}$

hasp 10 x  $1\frac{3}{4}$
