
Main Match Weapons & Ammunition Requirements

This will be a two-gun match. The main stages will be shot utilizing one rifle and one pistol. Soldiers of the Victorian Era did not often carry 2 pistols a rifle and a shotgun. Bring plenty lots of extra ammo. Both the Military Bolt and the Wild Bunch Match require ammunition that is loaded to Cowboy Action specifications. A period correct (pre-1917) pump shotgun will be required for the Wild Bunch Match.

DIRECTIONS TO RANGE



To get to Garnett: From I-35, take Olathe Exit 215 to US169, follow US169 south to Garnett.

Or take I-35 to Ottawa, and take Exit 183 and follow US59 south to Garnett. Turn east on either 6^{th} or 7^{th} Avenue, go to Nebraska.

Turn south on Nebraska, cross US169, follow road to site. There will be signs on US169, and US59, and at the entrance to the site.
